Laptop & Desktop Computers

All MATC faculty must have regular access to a *laptop or desktop* computer to manage their courses. Refer to these guidelines when preparing for class.



Hardware Requirements

CPU	Intel i3 processor or higher; or equivalent AMD 64-bit processor
Memory	4 GB RAM or higher
Hard Drive	500 GB or higher
Screen	15 inch color monitor (at least 1024x768 resolution recommended)
Internet Connectivity	Ethernet or reliable Wi-Fi connection
Battery Life	4 hours or higher
Peripherals	Sound card, speakers, printer
Storage	USB flash drive, external hard drive, or cloud storage

**Optional: A headset with microphone is recommended for use with Blackboard Collaborate or Google Hangout video conference calls.*

Mac OSx	10.13, 10.12, 10.11; 10.10
Chrome OS	Chromebook with Chrome Browser – Some limitations apply (see below).

**Respondus Lockdown Browser, Microsoft applications, or content requiring browser plugins may be inaccessible on Chrome OS.*

**Older versions of Windows and Mac are not supported, but may still access Blackboard with a supported web browser. Use with caution.*

**Linux operating systems are not compatible with MATC's online learning software.*
