


Copied/Pasted Content Breaks Page Layout and Content Reordering

Known Issue

After copying and pasting content from Word, e-mail, or other web-based resources into Blackboard, instructors may notice that the layout of content on pages becomes jumbled or misaligned. They may also experience that they can no longer re-order content on the page through the drag-drop function or re-ordering tool.

These errors typically indicate that conflicting HTML, CSS, or JavaScript code (brought into Blackboard through copying/pasting from the above mentioned sources) is affecting the page.



Announcements
New Announcements appear directly below the repositionable bar. Reorder by dragging Announcements to new positions. Move priority Announcements above the repositionable bar to pin them to the top of the list and prevent new Announcements from superseding them. The order shown here is the order presented to Students. Students do not see the bar and cannot reorder Announcements.

Recommended Solution

It is a best practice to avoid copying/pasting directly from Word. Instead, copy the formatted text and paste it into a plain text editor, such as Notepad or the [online Edit Pad](#) first. This will strip out the text's formatting and any code hiding behind the text. This cleaned up plain text can then be safely pasted back into Blackboard and re-formatted as desired.

Similarly, to resolve an instance where formatting and re-ordering functions have been affected by this error, copy the content from Blackboard and paste the content into a plain text editor to remove the conflicting code. Then, replace the effected content in Blackboard with the cleaned up plain text.
