

Late Test Attempt Scoring



Known Issue


ISSUE DESCRIPTION

If you assign a due date to a test and a student submits a test attempt *after* the test's due date, the test attempt will be marked as "Late" and placed in "Needs Grading" status in the course's Full Grade Center. When a student reviews an ungraded test attempt that was submitted late, the student may see his or her test's "Attempt Score" listed as a 0 grade while the late submission is in "Needs Grading" status.

Blackboard Client Support states that this is functioning as designed, but acknowledges that a late ungraded test attempt should list a student's "Attempt Score" as "Grade Not Available" while the test is pending grading.

WORKAROUND

If a student has submitted a late test attempt, [review the individual student's test attempt](#) and assign a grade for the test. The student's "Attempt Score" on the test will update once you have graded the student's late test attempt.

If you find that all of your students' test submissions are being marked as "Late", review each test's due date settings. It could be that your tests are referencing due dates from a prior semester and need to be updated. The course's [Date Management](#) tool is useful for reviewing and revising assessment due dates.
