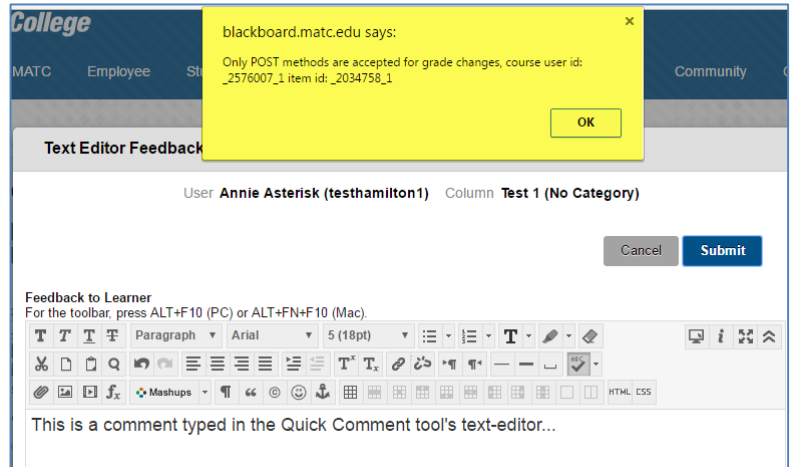
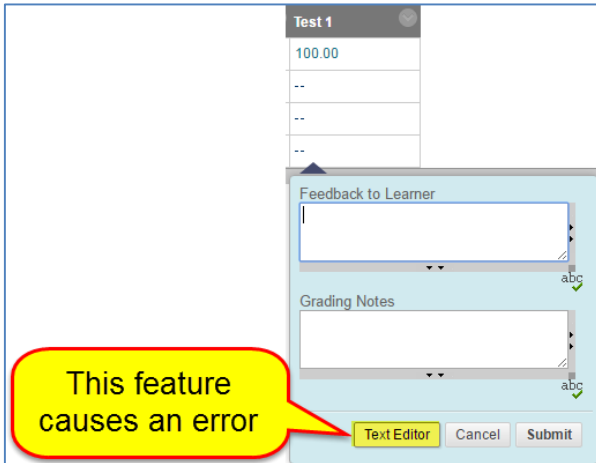


Quick Comment Tool's Expanded Text Editor Throws Error



Known Issue

Instructors utilizing the Grade Center's Quick Comment tool will notice that they can't submit comments created through the tool's expanded text-editor feature. Upon submit, the following error will display in a pop-up window: "Only POST methods are accepted for grade changes."



Blackboard acknowledges that this is a software defect that will be corrected in a future software update.

Recommended Action

To add simple unformatted comments to a student's grade, faculty may use the Quick Comment tool's default text-boxes for *Feedback to Learner* and *Grading Notes*.

To add formatted comments containing links to a grade, follow these steps instead:

1. Roll your mouse over the student's grade cell, click the gray arrow, and select **VIEW GRADE DETAILS**.
2. On the Grade Details page, click **EDIT GRADE**.
3. You will see a screen that lists the student's current grade. Type your feedback in the provided **FEEDBACK TO LEARNER** form.
4. When you are done, click the **SAVE** button.
