

How to Self-Enroll in a Community Organization in Blackboard



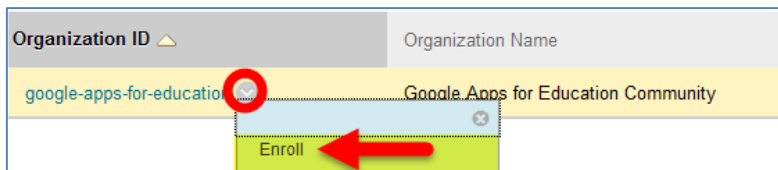

Participants may join an available organization that allows self-enrollment through these steps:

1. When logged into Blackboard, click on the **COMMUNITY** tab.
2. On the Community page, type the name of the community in the **ORGANIZATION SEARCH** text-box and click the **GO** button.



3. On the **BROWSE ORGANIZATION CATALOG** page, you will see a list of matching results and tools to refine your search. When you see the desired community in the search results, roll your mouse over the **NAME** of the community, click the **DOWN-ARROW** and select **ENROLL** from the menu that appears.



4. On the **SELF ENROLLMENT** page, click the **SUBMIT** button to confirm your enrollment.
5. You will see a confirmation message that you have successfully enrolled in the community. Click the **OK** button to exit the confirmation screen.
6. You will be taken directly to the community to begin viewing its contents.

How to Find Your Community

Once you are an enrolled participant, you may access your community when you are logged into Blackboard through the **MY ORGANIZATIONS** module on the **COMMUNITY** tab.
